

## Hide X-Powered-By: PHP

As so much in our beautiful world of IT it's very easy:

1. Open your php.ini in the editor of your trust.
2. Find this line:

```
; Decides whether PHP may expose the fact that it is installed on the server  
; (e.g. by adding its signature to the Web server header). It is no security  
; threat in any way, but it makes it possible to determine whether you use PHP  
; on your server or not.  
expose_php = On
```

3. Change the *On* to an *Off*.

```
expose_php = Off
```

4. Reload your Apache and the *X-Powered-By: PHP* header is gone.
