for some headers in jQuery Ajax you need to access XMLHttpRequest object

```
var xhr;
var _orgAjax = jQuery.ajaxSettings.xhr;
jQuery.ajaxSettings.xhr = function () {
  xhr = _orgAjax();
  return xhr;
};

$.ajax({
  type: "GET",
  url: 'http://example.com/redirect',
  success: function(data) {
    console.log(xhr.responseURL);
  }
});
```

or using plain javascript

```
var xhr = new XMLHttpRequest();
xhr.open('GET', "http://example.com/redirect", true);

xhr.onreadystatechange = function () {
  if (this.readyState == 4 && this.status == 200) {
    console.log(xhr.responseURL);
  }
};

xhr.send();
```
